

23 Transfusion Reaction

“Hemolytic, febrile or anaphylactic”

START

- ① Call for help, inform team, consider code cart/defibrillator
 - ▶ Ask: *“Who will be the crisis manager?”*
- ② Stop transfusion, save blood bag(s) for blood bank
- ③ Notify Blood bank 662-2121
- ④ Obtain blood (Purple top) and urine specimens for blood bank
- ⑤ For febrile reaction, give antipyretic and antihistamine
- ⑥ For hemolytic reaction, maintain urinary output, with IV fluids, diuretics, renal dose dopamine
- ⑦ Monitor for and treat DIC, TRALI. Postop ventilation, SCU as needed
